Artists Collective | Spartanburg in Spartanburg, SC invites all visual artists, 18 and older, residing in South Carolina, North Carolina, Georgia, Virginia, and Tennessee to apply for acceptance to the juried show.

This is the seventh juried exhibition presented by the Collective: an annual event to showcase the amazing diversity of work within this southern region.

Artists Collective | Spartanburg is the only studio art collective in Spartanburg County and art is produced and displayed throughout the 20,000 square foot building. The exhibitions, workshops, performances, and educational opportunities, along with artists' studios, create a unique environment: a one-of-a-kind facility housing individuals who share a common creative consciousness.

The nonprofit organization has 32 studios and more than 50 member artists. Visitors from across the region and beyond visit the Collective during major exhibitions.

● entry fee

A **non-refundable** fee of \$40 per artist for THREE (3) entries upon submission through our **Applied Arts** app at exhibitions.artistscollectivespartanburg.org.

All works will be allowed a single image per submission, plus one detail image. Entries will be accepted **Tuesday July 1 - Thursday July 31, 2025.**

● submissions

Only original works of art produced within the past three years will be accepted in the following media:

- **painting • drawing • sculpture • ceramic • glass**
- **photography • printmaking • jewelry • textile**
- **basketry • wood • mixed media • digital • ai**

No artwork from a kit or set will be accepted. Artists Collective | Spartanburg reserves the right to reject any work that differs dramatically from the image submitted.

Jewelry submissions must have their own secure vitrine.

All works to be hung must **be securely wired**, and if subject to damage, must be framed under plexiglas or glass. No sawtooth or clip mounting will be accepted.

Three-dimensional work must be able to sit solidly on a flat surface or be properly mounted for hanging, and must not exceed 36 inches in width or 72 inches in height, nor weigh more than 50 lbs. If works are not adequately prepared for display, they will be withdrawn from jurying.

Two-dimensional pieces should not exceed 36 inches by 48 inches including frame, regardless of orientation. Please keep in mind that entries must be transported or shipped by the artist and be prepared for hanging in a conventional gallery.

● liability

Artists Collective | Spartanburg does not assume responsibility for insuring the works of art. All artwork will be handled with care while in our possession.

Upon physical delivery of work after acceptance, Artists Collective | Spartanburg reserves the right to refuse any entry if the image presented online misrepresented the work, or the work presents a danger or liability to the viewing public, and also reserves the right to photograph and reproduce for educational or marketing purposes any entry submitted.

The receipt of an entry in the juried exhibition will constitute agreement by the artist to all conditions set forth in the prospectus.

● sale of work

All entries are available for sale unless otherwise noted. A 40% commission will be charged by Artists Collective | Spartanburg. If a work is Not For Sale, "NFS" must be noted on your entry card. No "POR" (Price On Requests) will be accepted. Works for sale must have price listed and will be sold as exhibited.

You may also choose to make your artwork available for sale online. The same terms apply.

Dwight Rose

Artist, educator, author

Dwight Rose is a professional artist, specializing in painting and teaching watercolor. After graduating with a BFA in painting from the Ringling College of Art and Design, he began his career in Sarasota, Florida. Exhibiting in local galleries, his paintings were recognizable with images of tropical landscapes and historic homes. Teaching for Ringling College, he later expanded his courses to community and museum programs.

In 2001 – 2007, Dwight lived in Doha, Qatar and traveled internationally. He captured images of the Middle East, China, Thailand, India, and many other countries. Once again in the college classroom, he enjoyed his diverse students. Exhibiting in Qatar, Turkey, and in the USA, his work was enjoyed and collected by an international audience.

Moving to Spartanburg in 2008, he's had numerous solo exhibitions in the region. An award-winning artist, his work has been in the SC Watermedia Society Traveling Exhibition. His work has been featured at Converse College, Blowing Rock History and Art Museum, the Peacock Gallery at the Middle Georgia State University, USC-Aiken Etherredge Center, and The ArtStation Stone Mountain, Georgia.

Dwight currently lives and has a studio in Bradenton, Florida. Most recently his work was featured in the Florida Watercolor Society 2023 juried online annual members show and 2024 annual juried members show and convention in St. Petersburg, Florida.

He taught for Greenville Center for the Creative Arts, Spartanburg Art Museum, and has offered many regional workshops. His work is in the collection of the City of Greer, Spartanburg County Public Library, the Hobcaw Barony, and many private collectors.
